# His Life Hid in Your Heart

Week 25: I Am... The Resurrection and the Life By Mike Vestal

What will it feel like to be resurrected? Have you ever thought about it that way? I mean, I think about what it will be like AFTER I come back from the dead, and I wonder what it will be like in Heaven. But I've never really stopped to consider that singular moment. The Bible says when I come back, it will be with a body—a spiritual body, but still something with weight to it. Will I be aware when all the parts of me 'come back online' after however many years I've been gone? Will it feel like when a body part falls asleep and starts to prickle as sensation starts to flow into it again? When will my eyes start to work, and what will be the first thing I see when my eyelids flutter open?

Jesus talks about the resurrection as an

event, one that he not only will be part of, but that cannot occur without him. We recall that he says this during a funeral. He mentions a new life twice in John 11, even though he still weeps at the occasion. And so there is something on the line when he says it— it's not just empty words, they have consequence when you're standing in a graveyard. So for us to appreciate the resurrection idea, and embrace the anticipation of a new life, we have to move (as Mike Vestal says in this week's devo) from the abstract to the concrete, in the person of Jesus.

Read a little each day, and be blessed! Do it everyday, and change your life!
