I love the fact that Jesus uses such ordinary, everyday items to express the magnitude of his ministry. Marie Antionette was famously beheaded by the common people of France for supposedly disparaging their starvation with the off-handed remark, "Let them eat cake..." (not fancy desert cake, mind you- they probably wouldn't have minded that very much!).
