Six warnings! All of which were ignored! As a result, 1500 passengers and crew lost their lives in the waters of the cold North Atlantic.

Week 46: Jesus and His Church

Each devotional thought by brother Hatfield this week comes from reading in Matthew 16:13-19. "The ten simple words, uttered by Peter, express profound truth: You are the Son of the living God." Robert will unfold in short but powerful ideas how meaningful those words are, then and now.

First there is the impact of Peter's confession— what does it mean to recognize and publicly proclaim the worship of a man who was more than a man? The implications for us as Christians today are obvious, but they need to be firmly planted in our hearts.

Then, there are the ideas built around Jesus' response to that statement. The church that Jesus would build, according to Hatfield, is "Christ's planned, possessed people." There's a great devotional

on Thursday about the future of that church, of which you and I have the chance to be part.

What does God want from us? What did Jesus die for? What's hidden in HIS heart about you and me? These questions can be explored when we spend a little bit of time meditating on these moments in his life. We get the chance to see his plan and our part in it, even when we don't understand everything going on around us. I am so glad to be able to trust in God's plan no matter what— just like Jesus did and just like Peter eventually does when he fully embraces the confession he made in this passage.

Think about that today and be blessed. Think on it everyday and change your life!
