We have one more event in the life of Christ to consider in this year's devotion-al study book before turning our full atten-tion to the road to Calvary. But before we get to those last and lasting thoughts, Travis Bookout has this week's devotional ideas on what it means to have the 'mind of Christ' as described in Philippians 2 and 3.

These are some of my favorite Bible verses in all of Scripture, because they so perfectly capture the notion that we must do more than simply read about and marvel at the life of Jesus. So many people study his story the same way they would Julius Cae-sar, George Washington, or Mozart. They find him fascinating, and they love thinking about the things he did and said that made an impact on the world. But they stop short

of thinking about his life in terms of some-thing we need to emulate ourselves. It doesn't translate to action on their part. That's where it all falls apart.

Without the assumption that the life of Christ is something we should take to heart as exemplary for our own, all the things we've read this entire year are just nice stories that make us feel warm and co-zy about this particular stretch of human history in this part of the world. It doesn't stick to us or shape us. This wasn't the point when the four Gospels were written!

Your life can and should be changed as you 'think on these things' and mold your life around them. Think about that to-day to be blessed. Think on it everyday to change your life!
