Week 44: Jesus and His Supper

This final Sunday of October brings us to one of the final events in the earthly life of Christ that was not somehow left in the hands of his captors. According to John 13, he'd already washed the disciples' feet by the time they celebrated Passover. Judas leaves after being given bread possibly dipped in the salt water and bitter herbs of the meal that represented the tears and bitterness of Israel before the Exodus. There's certainly symbolism in that!

Before they left the safety of that room for the darkness of Gethsemane, Jesus changed the lives of the apostles as well as ours by taking their meal and flipping it upside down. Everything would go wrong according to human perspective in a few hours, but before that would happen Jesus would upend the thinking of his followers first. The Master washing the serv-

ants' feet, the blood of a "new covenant," and the predicted betrayal of every single one of his followers must have been so disquieting for those in attendance.

But the Passover was one of the most sacred events in a Jew's year—and Jesus just altered it by talking about his own blood and body! I can only imagine how deeply that would have affected every person in that room each Sunday after Pentecost when they took the Supper with other Christians during worship. Can YOU see Jesus' face as he breaks the bread and passes it around? Can YOU feel the eerie quiet of the moment, and relive it when you tilt the cup to your mouth?

Think about that today to be blessed. Think on it everyday to change your life!
