Week 14: Bear One Another's Burdens

Our devotional book has moved into a series of themes that will carry us for several weeks, even months. They involve the “one another” sections of scripture, of which there are more than 30 different statements! I believe our book chooses to focus on 10 of them for the next couple of months, and they provide serious challenges to how we view one another in our daily lives and how our hearts should be shaped more like Christ’s heart in dealing with others.

Bo Shero has the task of calling us to consider how we can help bear one another's burdens, as the Bible directs us in Ephesians 6. It goes so far in that pas-

sage to say that in so doing, we are ‘fulfilling the law of Christ!’ What is the law of Christ, anyway? There might be different ways to answer that, but one way is a direct statement Jesus made in John talked about last week: “If you love me, keep my commandments.” What commandment was he so adamant about in this specific conversation? “a new command I give you– that you love one another, just as I have loved you...” So when Paul tells us to fulfill the law of Christ, and Christ says a critical command is to love one another, helping each other could fit the bill nicely!

Spend some time thinking about that today and be blessed. If you strive to put it to work everyday, without a doubt God will change your life for the better!
