"Come unto me, all ye that are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest....for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." (Matthew 11:28-30)

The key word in Matthew 11: 28-30 is "rest." Rest means "relief from crushing burdens, such as crippling anxiety, frustration, futility, and the misery of a sin-laden conscience." Therefore, Jesus gives three commands that precede this wonderful rest:

- 1. **Come.** The weight of sin is a heavy burden. Jesus relieves the heaviness of sin through forgiveness.
- Take. It was the custom of students to attach themselves to their teacher. It was called "yoked."
- 3. Learn. We must never cease studying and searching the Bible to learn about Jesus.
